### Paris FIFDH 2016

The 14<sup>th</sup> edition of the Paris International Human Rights Film Festival will be held during spring 2016 in Paris and Ile-de-France. You can now submit your **documentary, fiction and animation films!**

#### PRESENTATION & MISSION

The Paris International Human Rights Film Festival promotes each year a selection of the best movies on human rights issues emphasizing both the artistic qualities and the strength of the content. The screenings are followed by Q&As with directors and experts, journalists, civil society members, etc. The Festival is now renowned as the most prominent cultural event on human rights in France.

During the past few years, the Festival has grown in several territories: Paris, Ile-de-France and other regions (Strasbourg, Nantes, Metz, La Reunion, Provence, Toulouse & Midi-Pyrénées, Gard, Gironde, Haute-Savoie and Pays Basque) and internationally (Togo, République centrafricaine, Cameroun, Madagascar et Tunisie). In addition to this geographical development, the Festival is constantly working to spread the influence of those movies altering the public to human rights issues: video production workshops for groups of young people, screenings and Q&As in prison, master classes, book fairs, round table discussions...

#### FILM SUBMISSION

**In order to submit your film, please follow these 3 easy steps:**

- > Read and accept the Festival's rules and regulations.
- > Complete the submission form.

#### Conditions for participation:

- > The films must have been produced **after January 1, 2014**.
- > The submission deadline is **September 30<sup>th</sup> 2015**. Movies sent early will have more chance to be selected.
- > The submission is free of charge.
- > The Festival screens principally documentary films. But you can also submit your fiction and animation movies.
- > Feature films must last a **minimum of 52 minutes**. There is no maximum duration limit.
- > Short films must last **between 1 and 20 minutes**.
- > For the selection process, the film will be watched in French, French subtitled, English or English subtitled version only.
- > A notification of selection will be sent to the participant in the course of November 2015.
